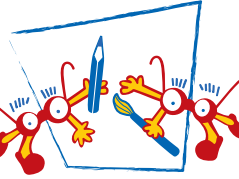
AFTER SCHOOL CLASSES

One class per term (Wk 3) is an anatomy study class. Full tuition throughout the class.
